
on "Fading History -Stories of Historical Interest"

William James ("Bill") Tennison passed away on November 25, 2012 at the age of 83. Bill and Sylvia have been enthusiastic supporters of the Swansea Historical Society ever since its founding in the 1980s. Bill's many interests included Dixieland music, Canadian art, and Scouting. At two of our recent meetings, he shared with us items from his extensive collections of art by Cornelius Krieghoff and Nicholas Hornyansky. A few of us attended Bill's service at St. Giles in Etobicoke, along with the surviving members of his musical group and a large contingent from the Scouting world. It was a wonderful celebration of Bill's life. In keeping with his wishes, the recessional was a hand-clapping Dixieland rendition of "When the Saints Go Marching In".

Dr. Robert D. ("Bob") McIntyre, QC passed away on November 30, 2012 at the age of 73. Bob grew up in Swansea, and attended Swansea Public School, Humberside Collegiate, and the University of Western Ontario. For 45 years, he practiced law in Brampton, Ontario, where he volunteered in leadership positions in many community organizations. A few years ago, Bob reconnected with Swansea by joining our Swansea Historical Society.
